The TurboTAP Mobile Training Team (TTAP MTT) provides a full array of programs and services that assist servicemembers who are coming on and off of active duty (Guard and Reserve), as well as those who are separating from military services or retiring at the end of a military career. Supportive transition assistance and deployment reintegration resources and referrals are also provided to family members of transitioning military members.
